Concept of Work-sharing

"To share examination-related information between patent offices so as to improve the quality of examination of patent applications, to reduce duplication of works, to advance efficiency of patent examination, and to strengthen cooperation between offices for the sake of user convenience"

Examiners Exchange Program

Objective

- To understand examination practice and patent system of the counterpart through examination practice-oriented work sharing and to build mutual trust for examination quality

Main Contents

- To select a specific technical field, conduct a joint prior art search and determine patentability regarding patent applications jointly filed with the two offices
- * Procedure : (1) Select a technical field \rightarrow (2) Choose participants (2~4 examiners of each office) \rightarrow (3) Implement a sampling process for jointly filed applications \rightarrow (4) Conduct a prior art search and determine patentability \rightarrow (5) Prior exchange of search results \rightarrow (6) Comparison analysis of search results (cross visit of the project partners)
- Group discussion regarding patent examination issues as a whole, especially focusing on examination guidelines, patent system and the partner's examination practice, as well as examination of jointly filed applications and sharing of recent issues

Experts Exchange Program

Objective

- To promote understanding of major works of offices and strengthen cooperation between the offices through mutual support by dispatching experts to the counterpart

Main Contents

- To share status updates regarding major works of the counterpart
- To analyze patent quality, share status updates of quality control and discuss the best way forward for development
 - To discover promising projects for work-sharing by dispatching experts to the counterpart

Status Updates

- CPC project experts dispatched to the USPTO in 2013 (6 months)
- PPH project experts dispatched to the USPTO in 2015 (6 months)
- CPC quality analyzing experts dispatched to the USPTO in 2018 (6 months)

Examiners & Experts Exchange Program

Benefits

- Further understand patent system and examination practices of the counterpart
- Find a development direction for administration of patent as a whole
- Discover a way forward to quality improvement of examination
- Build mutual trust with the counterpart for examination quality & administration

Patent Experts Meeting

Objective

- To strengthen mutual cooperation by discussing patent system as a whole

Main Contents

- Comparison of patent system and examination guidelines and sharing of recent amendments
- Sharing and discussion of patent examination policy and relevant statistics
- Studying of examination cases
- Sharing and discussion of quality control policy
- Sharing of recent issues regarding international patent cooperation
- Discussion of the best way forward for mutual cooperation with respect to the international patent cooperation

Status Updates

- KIPO-SIPO in progress, KIPO-SIPO-JPO suspended since 2016

Patent Experts Meeting

Benefits

- Mutual exchange of patent system between the offices
- More responsive to the current global issues
- Discovering patent cooperation program between the offices
- Strenthening cooperation between the offices by setting up a regular specialized assembly

Other Work-sharing Programs of KIPO

The Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH)

- With respect to the same invention determined patentable by an Office of Earlier Examination (OEE), an Office of Later Examination (OLE) performs an accelerated examination thereon
- Bilateral PPHs, IP5 PPH and Global PPH in progress

The Collaborative Search Program (CSP)


- Sharing of prior art references between offices before starting the substantive examination
- KIPO-USPTO CSP, JPO-USPTO CSP in progress
- KIPO-SIPO CSP, KIPO-UKIPO CSP in preparation

The Collaborative Search and Examination (CS&E) under the PCT

- The five IP offices' cooperation in performing international search under the PCT
- No additional fees to applicants during the pilot project
 - * The due date of the operation phase: July 2018

CSP (Collaborative Search Program)

- Commence a procedure upon the request from a patent applicant
- Share information of prior art references before starting substantive examination (patentability is independently determined by each participant)
- Early examination may incur an effect of accelerated examination
- Status updates 2nd CSP pilot project between KIPO-USPTO (in progress), KIPO-SIPO, KIPO-UKIPO CSP project (expected)



Goals of Work-sharing

- To raise quality of patent examination
- To reflect user needs and encourage user participation
- To actively respond to the change of outside patent environment
- To strengthen relationship between/among Offices
