This round table will focus on discussing the issues arising from the process of creating and using objects for IP rights protection in implementing programs and

projects financed from the state budget, as well as in the military-technical cooperation and foreign economic activity with regard to controlled products.

The issue of stimulating the creation (identification) of the protected results of intellectual activity, their legal protection and involvement of rights in the economic and civil law turnover affects the interests of both the employee and the employer. For the state customer, this issue is also becoming more and more relevant in the context of changes in the regulatory framework of intellectual property. The effectiveness of budget allocations to R&D depends on how well the interests of all three parties to civil law relations are coordinated. How to achieve coherence?

The use of intellectual property, which belongs to organizations, obtained from their own funds in the course of implementation of programs and projects financed from the state budget, carries the risks of loss of rights and thus levels the initiative to find and offer ready-made solutions, which is potentially associated with reduction of time and budget expenditures on R&D and implementation of their results. How to settle this issue?

In the course of military-technical cooperation, the role of technological interaction with foreign customers becomes increasingly important. How to improve the efficiency of intellectual property use in the Russian Federation and Russian organizations?

The section will discuss changes in legislation in connection with entry into force of the Federal Law № 230-FZ dated July 26, 2019 «On Amendments to Part Four of the Civil Code of the Russian Federation and Articles 1 and 23¹ of the Federal Law «On State Regulation of Production and Circulation of Ethyl Alcohol, Alcoholic and Alcohol-containing products and on limiting consumption (drinking) of alcoholic beverages».

The focus will be on the following issues: legal protection of developments in the pharmaceutical field during the pandemic, the most promising developments and the soonest possible leading of drugs to industrial production, the problem of patent rights protection of manufacturers of original (reference) drugs overcoming risks for development of innovative developments in the Russian Federation.

The conference will include a round table on circulation of pharmaceuticals and its relationship to intellectual property.

At present, practical issues related to obtaining patents for objects of patent law and their use in civil circulation are of interest to various sectors of society, as they affect such a sensitive area as creation and use of pharmaceuticals.

The process of development of modern digital technologies stimulated creation of new platforms for generating and using the results of intellectual activity. It became possible due to the development of informational telecom networks, including “the Internet”.

In modern world more processes, including business-processes, are carried out in the digital environment. Thus, understanding the main principles of functioning of the digital environment itself allows to optimize the mechanisms of use of the objects of intellectual property rights and reduce the costs for its commercialization.

The issues of protection and enforcement of copyright remain relevant to all spheres of society, especially in the context of digital economy.

At the same time protection of copyright in the digital sphere is complicated by various factors, including extraterritorial character of the “the Internet” and constant modernization of the informational environment. However, despite major influence of digital technologies on the life of modern society, the instances of copyright infringement in the digital environment became more common, thus showing the lack of legal regulation in this field. Joint round tables of Rospatent and FICPI Russian group have already become traditional. This year the conference is held in unusual environment, when the

possibilities of communication, including professional discussion of any issues, are very limited. For the first time, the traditional conference of Rospatent will be held online. Precisely these electronic formats of interaction between Rospatent and users of the system of legal protection of industrial property will become the topic of our joint round table: “Modern electronic forms of interaction of the Patent Office with applicants, stakeholders and their representatives. Looking for the best practices”.

FICPI gives focused attention to the development of new forms of interaction between attorneys and the Patent Office. In particular, in 2019, the FICPI Executive Committee adopted a resolution on online filing systems for Patent Offices. Patent Offices offer a wide range of forms of electronic interaction: by e-mail, via the Internet site, through a personal account, etc. However, despite the indisputable convenience and progressiveness of the paperless technology of interaction with the Office, not all applicants and their representatives use the appropriate systems and know about all the positive aspects of such interaction.

The events of recent months related to COVID-19 have shown that electronic forms of interaction between the Patent Office and consumers of its services are not only the most convenient, but sometimes the only possible form of interaction. However, situations in which the submission of documents in electronic form to the Office is either not yet provided for, or is not sufficiently regulated, or involves additional submission of paper copies of documents are known.

A joint interested discussion of the Russian and international experience in this area will make it possible to work out the most rational ways of developing electronic systems for the interaction of the Patent Office with applicants, stakeholders and their representatives. Discussion of the above and other problems at the proposed joint round table will allow to attract leading experts in this field, including leading experts and specialists of the Russian Patent Office, as well as highly qualified Russian and foreign specialists, to the dialogue.

"Do we need an opposition procedure for patentable industrial designs?"

Video Conference

In recent years, the legal protection of industrial designs has been developing rapidly. Modernization of the legislation, which took place in 2014 with the amendments to the Civil Code of the Russian Federation, the ratification of the Geneva Act of the Hague Agreement on the International Registration of Industrial Designs in 2017 and the introduction of temporary legal protection for industrial designs in 2019 gave the expected results. The annual number of applications for industrial design patents demonstrates growth dynamics even in unfavorable economic conditions.

Organizational and technological measures taken by Rospatent, including the introduction of information technologies, made it possible to significantly reduce the processing time for industrial design applications, which, of course, was positively interpreted by the designers. However, with the expected even greater number of applications, the obtained deadline goals may be unattainable. In this regard, Rospatent is considering the idea of further improving the legislation related to industrial designs.

In particular, the issue of introducing a pre-registration opposition procedure is being considered, which will allow holders of senior rights to industrial designs and other intellectual property items used in an industrial design to submit their objections in the process of considering an application for an industrial design. The examination of the patentability of an industrial design within the framework of the substantive examination in connection with the introduction of such opposition will be carried out under a limited number of conditions of patentability.

Within the framework of the section, it is planned to discuss issues related to the application of opposition procedures in different legal regimes. The discussion will allow to get acquainted with the experience of legal regulation in other countries, take into account the best practices of legal regulation and the opinions of experts in the work on improving the legislation of the Russian Federation.

The Federal Law No. 262-FZ dated July 31, 2020, amended the Civil Code to provide for the involvement of organizations accredited by Rospatent in conducting preliminary information search and assessing patentability as part of the examination of applications for inventions and utility models.

In order to implement this initiative, it is proposed to provide the applicant with the right to apply to an accredited organization in order to receive the results of preliminary information search and assessment of the patentability of the claimed technical solution, which will be used in the examination of the application.

As accredited organizations, Russian organizations operating in specific areas of technology will be involved, in the staff of which there are experts with competencies in the field of information search and assessment of the patentability of technical solutions. In particular, such organizations could be institutions of the Russian Academy of Sciences, research institutes, leading universities.

Within the framework of the round table, it is proposed to discuss issues arising in connection with the adoption of abovementioned federal law, in particular:

- how the applicant would benefit from the accredited organization?
- how will obtaining the results of preliminary information search and patentability assessment affect the examination period for an application?
- how will the confidentiality of the application materials be ensured?
- is this practice used in application examination by other patent offices?
